

Here is a descriptive list of Water Quality Improvement Grants for the 2020 cycle:

- ADOT - closure of unauthorized roadside parking alongside Oak Creek on Highway 89A
- AZGFD - South Legunita Grassland Restoration project (also known as the Santa Margarita Ranch project) and Buenos Aires National Wildlife Refuge (BANWR) Grassland Restoration project
- AZ State Parks - Installation of fence along Oak Creek State Park on Highway 89A to manage recreation visitation, mitigate E.coli pollution, and ensure visitor safety
- U of A Master Watershed Steward Program - partnership with Dr. Guertin to provide estimated pollutant load reductions from impaired surface waterbodies
- McKinley Mine - remediation of historical legacy mining site in Bradshaw mountains
- National Forest Foundation - rehabilitation of social trails alongside Oak Creek to mitigate E.coli pollution
- Natural Channel Design - engineering, planning, and implementation of social trail rehabilitation and closure alongside Oak Creek
- Oak Creek Watershed Council - trash removal and water quality sampling in Oak Creek to measure E.coli contamination
- Oak Creek Watershed Council - planning and installation of pet waste stations in Oak Creek
- Watershed Management Group - Sonora, Mexico partnerships and best management practices education for ranching communities to help protect San Pedro River
